The FAIR Plan has replaced its forty year old legacy operating system. In addition to gaining numerous policy processing efficiencies, the FAIR Plan is introducing several enhancements to assist producers.

Producers and insureds will be able to go on line and gain access to secure portals to view and print their policy documents, submit new business, make payments, report a claim or request changes to the policy. Please see the instructions on our website under the What's New tab, Producer Documentation, on how to register and navigate the policy screens.

Full premium payment was previously required to issue a new or renewal policy. A two pay plan is now available (60% up front, 40% due in 90 days). Billing options include insured direct, mortgagee, or producer.

The new system will also allow the FAIR Plan to offer a greater range of higher deductibles, rather than just \$250 for dwelling and \$500 for commercial policies.

The FAIR Plan is also introducing an end of month commission statement that replaces the individual issued commission check for each transaction.


The FAIR Plan is introducing a Residential Crime Insurance Endorsement CR 101 FP 04 17 to the Dwelling Property policy form that replaces the Residential Crime policy. Please view the form on our website under the Request Tab, Downloadable forms.



The website new business application request is now structured to gather information in a logical sequence by category tabs. Certain answers may require additional information that only appears if necessary. An application can be printed at the end of the process. If the application is complete and acceptable and payment is made, the policy can be issued immediately.
